

## Frank Stella: Darabjerd III

**Frank Stella** is an Italian American artist who used a protractor as his basic unit in the *Protractor* series. This painting's title, *Darabjerd III*, refers to an ancient city in Asia Minor built on a circular plan.

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## **Discussion**

Students analyze Stella's geometric color composition and learn about his Minimalist style.

They identify radial symmetry, analogous colors, tertiary colors, and hardedge shapes. They discuss the balance, asymmetry and the mathematical implication of overlapping intersecting shapes.

## **Project: Color Fans**

Students draw and arrange protractor shapes using radial symmetry to paint color wedges using analogous and tertiary colors in a non-objective color study.
